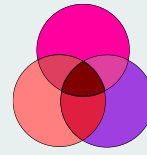
- To enhance existing services and create a flexible system to meet the individual needs of people with developmental disabilities throughout Chelan and Douglas Counties.

Chelan-Douglas Developmental Disabilities (CDDD) serves as the coordinating agency for State funded providers in Chelan and Douglas counties. The CDDD Program is also responsible for educating and informing individuals, families, professionals, and the greater community about “abilities” of persons with developmental disabilities in life and work.

Referrals to our programs are made through the Washington State Department of Social and Health Services, Developmental Disabilities Administration, and Department of Vocational Rehabilitation.

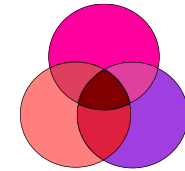
