This proposition would authorize the District to levy the following excess taxes, in place of an expiring levy, upon all taxable property within the District, for support of the District's educational programs and operation expenses not funded by the State:

Bonds To Expand and Renovate School Facilities and Improve Safety and Security

The Board of Directors of Ephrata School District No. 165/55J adopted Resolution No. 2018-19-3, concerning a proposition to relieve overcrowding and improve safety and infrastructure. This proposition would authorize the District to: construct a classroom addition at Columbia Ridge; make District-wide safety and security improvements; replace roofs at Columbia Ridge, Grant, Middle and High Schools; construct 3 new multipurpose gymnasiums (Columbia Ridge, Grant and Middle School); renovate the Performing Arts Center and gymnasium; issue no more than \$27,893,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 20 years; and levy annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 2018-19-3.
