**Hospital District One Year Excess Levy**

The Douglas County Hospital District No. 2 (Ambulance Services) Board of Commissioners adopted Resolution #75 on November 15, 2017, containing a proposition to finance maintenance and operation. This proposition would authorize the District to levy excess taxes upon all taxable property within the District in the sum of \$70,000, requiring collection of approximately \$0.36 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation in 2019.
