- MINOR GUARDIANSHIPS (limited)
- MODIFICATIONS OF CHILD SUPPORT OR PARENTING PLAN
- TEMPORARY FAMILY LAW ORDERS

FAMILY LAW COURT FACILITATOR CAN ASSIST IN THE FOLLOWING WAYS:

- Provide information on basic Court procedures (Including Requirements for service, filing, scheduling hearings and complying with local Court Rules.)
- Assist in selection of forms and instructions
- Explaining Legal Terms
- Assist in completing approved forms
- Reviewing completed forms to determine whether or not forms are complete
- Assisting calculating child support based on financial information provided by the litigant
- Review documents prior to hearings to determine whether procedural requirements have been met
- Assistance in preparation of Court orders
- Make referrals to legal and social service resources, dispute resolution, and resources for family law forms and instructions
