Gina Stark, Staff to the ABLA Advisory Group, (Department of Commerce) will be presenting:

- *The workshop will educate communities about the available opportunities to save and plan for a better economic future and quality of life experience through the establishment of ABLA accounts.*
- *New ABLA accounts will allow eligible individuals with disabilities to create tax-advantaged savings accounts with contributions of up to \$14,000 annually. ABLA allows for more individual control over spending and investing, while protecting eligibility for Medicaid, Supplemental Security Income and other means-tested public benefits.*
- *In order to be eligible for an ABLA account, the beneficiary must be someone who had a disability (developmental, physical, mental, traumatic brain injury) that occurred before he or she turned 26.*
